## **Top 25 Winning Tips for Slots Players**

- 1. At a bare minimum, keep gambling records for annual tax preparation including date, location, and amount spent.
- 2. Join your casino's player club for the benefits of complimentary gifts and invitations to promotional events.
- 3. Other slots players are aware of top winning strategies. They just don't talk about it with others, usually.
- 4. Older-style slot machines set to high payout percentages should be played as long as possible, in shifts if possible, until the odds are physically changed per the casino's schedule.
- 5. Players should fully understand their gambling goals to be able to carefully focus on achieving them.
- 6. When a player is at a high enough level, if their executive host is not on the casino premises, non-executive hosts are on stand-by to come see a player immediately upon their putting their player club card into any slot machine. In either case, a host shows up in less than a minute.
- 7. Be ready to win big, even if it's unlikely to actually happen. It only matters if it is possible.
- 8. Bonus rounds are typically only possible to activate when playing maximum credits.
- 9. Advancements in slot machine technology has made hosting tournaments far easier for casinos when used as promotional events.
- 10. Rewards club "experts" are not fully knowledgeable about their casino's rewards program because they aren't members.
- 11. Build good relationships with casino hosts, whether or not a specific host has yet been assigned to you.
- 12. Advantage players try to find an advantage that potentially increases their revenue and especially their subsequent profit.
- 13. Gamblers like people teaching them how to win, but after being taught wish those teachers would stop teaching others.
- 14. There are effectively two types of gambling cruise ships for players, those that are almost exclusively for gambling and those that happen to have gambling available on them.
- 15. Older-style slot machine rule #3: Find a machine at or near the end of a row of machines that is near an area where people naturally group together that also follow rules #1 and #2.
- 16. Heightened sensory stimulus are observed to be experienced by the players from the machines when even small wins occur.
- 17. Typically, for taxable jackpots, a slot attendant collects I.D., writes a receipt, performs a payout, and unlocks the machine.
- 18. High-level players can be expected to be aware of many top strategies, and to successfully learn those being used by others.

- 19. After quite a bit of repetition, it is possible to adapt or otherwise get used to winning jackpots up to \$10,000.
- 20. The gaming industry depends on the appeal of gaming offerings to its customers and players and the general acceptance of gaming.
- 21. With proper record keeping, gambling losses used as tax deductibles can refund some or all of paid taxes on taxable jackpots.
- 22. The maximum bet is typically the only way to activate any potential bonus rounds available within the game theme.
- 23. Casinos with a higher level of reputation typically earn better business performance results.
- 24. The operators of online video slot social media games are making profits without having to make any payouts to their patrons.
- 25. Understanding the history of slot machine development provides insight into the next technological advancements to expect.
